Colgate University students were invited to participate in the HEDS Sexual Assault Campus Climate survey from February 5 to February 24th. The survey covered topics relating to personal experiences of sexual violence as well as awareness, prevention, and survivor support. Participation was entirely voluntary, and students had the opportunity to skip any questions they chose. Some of the content of this survey is required by the New York State Enough is Enough Law.

This document includes information that may be difficult for survivors of sexual violence or for those close to them.

Through the end of April, students can continue share their experiences of sexual violence or how they have been affected by the experiences of others for anonymous use in institutional research. Analysis of responses should be available during the upcoming academic year.

Based on the recommendation of the Assessment Committee, this report is being made publicly available at this time. There are several confidential resources available to students. A counselor is available for walk-ins Monday-Friday from 1:30-4:30 p.m. in Conant House. After office hours, an on-call counselor is available nights and weekends and can be reached through calling campus safety (315-228-7333) and asking for the counselor on call. Students can make an appointment to meet with a counselor at Haven by calling the Counseling Center at 315-228-7385. Students who may not want to speak with a counselor can meet with Haven's Program Coordinator, Tracia Banuelos, by calling her at 315-228-4286 or by emailing her at tbanuelos@colgate.edu. University chaplains are available at the Office of the Chaplains in the garden level of the Colgate Chapel or by calling 315-228-7682.
